

Photoshop for Fashion and Textile Design

This course explores the creative process and ways to design fashion and textiles using Photoshop, allowing you to present your ideas from inspiration to final concept in a digital format.

The course covers the following main topics:

- Create textile motifs and design elements from scanned images, photographs or drawing tools
- Apply artistic effects and fabrics to scanned fashion illustrations
- Visualise your ideas, develop colourways and design variations

The tutor will provide images for you to work from during the course. You are welcome to bring in examples of your own fashion work on a USB stick (e.g. inspirational images, photographs, scanned drawings and designs).

Requirements and Suitability

This course is suitable for beginners or those that have a basic knowledge of Photoshop.

Participants are required to have basic computer skills. Therefore, all students are expected to be confident in using a computer for tasks such as word processing, saving, managing files, browsing the internet etc.

Please bring a pen, notebook and USB stick to save your work.
